

Support for the reading test

Overview

To show that they meet the HSC minimum standard, students need to achieve a Level 3 or 4 in a short online reading test of skills for everyday life.

Modelled on the NESA online test, the following links provide access to practice tests. They are self-marking quizzes that provide students with immediate feedback on their answers. Students can answer questions via the following links through their student login to deepen their skills in reading.
