Guidelines of Ensemble participation

- Black PAE Shirt is compulsory for performances and is available for purchase from the uniform shop. Students will also need a pair of plain, black dress trousers and black shoes.

- ♬ Be prompt for the rehearsal, set up and pack up the room.
- Attend rehearsals with your MUSIC and a PENCIL.
- ♬ Participation in the Stage Band firstly requires membership of a Concert Band.

Leaving an Ensemble

B Ensembles run for the entire year and written confirmation by parents is required if students wish to leave early. If the student leaves the music program during the year, no refund of fees will be paid.
