

Zone Athletics Carnival 2017

Congratulations to all students who have been chosen to represent Killara High School at the Zone Athletics Carnival. The details are as follows:

Date:	Wednesday 14 June 2017
Bus Departs KHS:	7:00am
Carnival Start:	First races start at 8:00am (3000m and Hurdles)
Carnival End:	Final race at 2.45pm
Location:	Sydney Athletic Centre, Homebush
Supervising Teachers:	Mrs. Shapiro and Mr. Bruckshaw

Students are to meet in front of the school no later than 6:50am. The bus will be leaving the venue at approximately 3:00pm, after the last race. It will **not** return to school in time for students to catch normal afternoon buses home. Students will be allowed to disembark at Gordon Station prior to the buses' return to Killara High School around 3:40pm.

Parents are welcome to attend the carnival. Any student wishing to make his or her own way to or from the Athletic Centre must indicate this when providing consent. **It is recommended that students participating in the first races of the day (3000m and Hurdles) be transported to the venue by a parent.**

All students are expected to follow the school's code of behaviour. Students are required to wear **full sports uniform**. An athletics singlet will be provided on the day. Any student who is not in full sports uniform will not be allowed to attend the carnival.

Students who have asthma or other medical issues will need to bring their medication on the day and consult with Mrs Shapiro about procedures.

There is a canteen at the venue, however, it is advisable that students bring their own food and drink. Killara High School students will participate in the carnival as a team and will be expected to stay in their area and support their team mates when not competing themselves.

A series of training sessions will be held in Term Two in preparation for the carnival. Track event training is scheduled for Wednesday mornings in Weeks 3, 5 and 7. Training for field events is scheduled for Friday mornings in Weeks 4 and 6. All sessions will be held from 7:30am- 8:30am. It is recommended that students attend training to enhance their skill and confidence prior to the carnival.
