Dear Parents and Caregivers,

Open's Girls Water Polo Knockout Competition

Your daughter has been selected for the Open's Girls Water Polo Knockout competition. This competition will be held on **March 13, 2017** at **Ryde Aquatic Leisure Centre** between **9 am and 3 pm**. Students will meet at **Killara High School** on the morning of competition at **7:30 am** and will be transported to the venue. Students will be transported from the venue to Killara High School following the competition. Students may need to find their own way home, as we may not arrive back in time for afternoon buses. Mrs Shapiro will be able to transport some students to and from the venue. We will however, need the assistance of parent volunteers. If you are able to assist, please indicate this on the consent form.

Students should wear their swimming costume to school under their PE uniform, and should bring a cap, goggles and a towel. The state and national controlling bodies of this sport strongly also recommend the wearing of a correctly fitted mouthguard during competition. **Each student must pay \$7.00 for general admission at the pool.** Each student is responsible for paying this amount on the competition day.
