YEAR 11 and 12 Hospitality and Food

An excursion has been organised for Year 11 and 12 Hospitality and Food Technology Students to the Good Food and Wine Show. The show is held at the International Convention Centre in Darling Harbour in Sydney. All students will meet at Killara station at 9am and travel together to the Convention Centre.

The purpose of the excursion is to discover new foods and the latest products on the market. Students will also watch celebrity chefs on stage, and perhaps participate in educational masterclasses and look through hundreds of local and international exhibitors at the show.

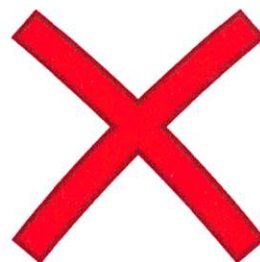
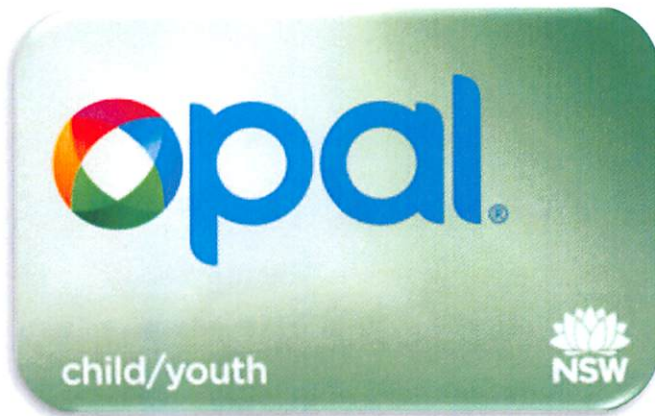
