An excursion has been arranged for students to visit Macquarie University where they will be involved in collecting water samples around the campus, carrying out water testing and viewing demonstrations in the university laboratories.

This excursion will cover compulsory sections of the Stage 6 HSC Chemistry course. The excursion constitutes part of Assessment 5 in this course.

The arrangements are as follows:

Date: Tuesday 27th June – 12Che2 and 12Che6B (Mr Hendriks and Mrs Arora)
Wednesday 28th June – 12Che3 and 12Che5 (Mrs Arora and Mr Hendriks)

Departure Time: Students and teachers will meet at 8.15am at Killara Station

Travel: By train

Dress: Students are to wear their Year 12 jersey, school jumper or school jacket, long pants and sensible footwear

Return Time: Approximately 4pm at Killara Station. Students will be dismissed from Killara Station.

Requirements: Bring clipboard and pen.
Canteen facilities are available

Cost: \$52 – to be paid by 20th June 2017
Students will purchase their own train ticket. Students will need to have the cost of train ticket on credit on their Child/Youth card. School Opal Cards cannot be used on excursions.


