Every public school in NSW uses a Strategic Improvement Plan to shape the direction of the school and determine priority areas for growth and improvement. This is a 4 year planning cycle, with drafting and consultations occurring now and the plan commencing in 2021.

Our plan has 3 Strategic Directions, which together define our strategic vision. Within each Strategic Direction are 3 priority areas which show how each Strategic Direction will be achieved. Implementing these priorities involves retaining and strengthening some aspects of school operations, improving others, and making changes where required.

The Draft Strategic Directions presented here, and the priority areas within each, are the result of in-depth consultations with teachers, school leaders, and the Killara P&C starting back in June 2020. Our next step is to consult with the wider community (this survey) and our students at school.
